### Summary

- Analyzing and interpreting new and proposed legislation and implementing regulations;
- Assisting in the formulation of policy. Participating in the drafting of regulations, interpretive releases, and policy briefing materials for agency officials in the municipal securities area;
- Performing legal research and analysis to formulate and recommend legal courses of action on matters affecting municipal securities;
